This workshop will explore the needs of the partner regions and understand how to match the knowledge generated in the co-innovation labs with the Fellow regions; it will help to define expectations of the twinning results in an ambitious but realistic way. The methodology for coordinating the exchange and fostering mutual learning, the actors to be involved and the expected results will also be discussed.

> This workshop will lay the groundwork for Task 9.3 which addresses financial investment systems, natural capital accounting and innovation in green business models. Through an interactive session, a preliminary exploration of the needs of the partner regions will be carried out and existing resources, including partners' financial expertise, will be identified.
